

**PRINCETON ELEMENTARY SCHOOL
DISTRICT #115
BOARD OF EDUCATION
Regular Meeting
October 25, 2021**

The regular meeting of the Princeton Elementary District #115 Board of Education was held Monday, October 25, 2021, at Logan Jr. High. The meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m. by President Steve Bouslog. The roll was called with the following members in attendance: Catherine Dye, Susan Garvin, Blake Jacobs, Judd Lusher, and Pete Reviglio, as well as President Bouslog. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Superintendent J.D. Orwig and Recording Secretary Lisa Bettner as well as several staff were also present.

Agenda Amendments: None.

Public Participation: None.

Program Recognition: On October 14, 2021, Mr. Bouslog and Mrs. Garvin attended the IASB Fall meeting. They briefly shared information from that meeting. In addition, they announced that Mr. Lusher was recognized at that meeting as “Master School Board Member” and awarded him with his certificate of recognition.

Approval of Agenda: Motion made by Mr. Jacobs, second by Mr. Reviglio, to approve the agenda. All ayes. Motion carried.

Approval of Consent Agenda Items: Motion made by Mrs. Dye, second by Mrs. Garvin, to approve the Consent Agenda. Roll call vote. All ayes. Motion carried. Mrs. Arkels absent.

Administrative/Staff Presentation: The 2021 Softball and Cross Country coaches/teams were recognized. Cross Country Coach Zach Clark, and Softball coaches Kevin Alt, Tim Parry, and Elizabeth Klingenberg presented to the board the team stats and accomplishments of each team this year. The Softball team were the regional champs and had 15 students participate on the team. The Cross Country team had 4 students that went to state and had a very successful year.

Superintendent’s Report:

Mr. Orwig presented the financial report and reviewed the detail of same report. The end of the first financial quarter was on September 30. Mr. Orwig highlighted the Education Fund, Building Fund and Transportation Fund details. In total we are at 26.44% expended thus far and at 48.62% funds received at this time.

Informational Items:

Mr. Orwig updated the board on the Return to Learn plan. The district has been 27 days without a case of COVID; however, there were 2 new positive cases today.

Motion made by Mr. Jacobs, second by Mr. Reviglio, to accept the FY 21 Financial Audit as presented. Roll call vote. All ayes. Mrs. Arkels absent. Motion carried.

Motion made by Mr. Jacobs, second by Mr. Lusher, to approve the Starved Rock Division Governing Board. All ayes. Motion carried.

Future District / Board Considerations: Mr. Bouslog asked that next month we have the Superintendent Evaluation added to the Informational Items list to begin discussing.

Mr. Jacobs asked to add to the November meeting an item to discuss the Board being more visible and visiting the schools be placed for discussion.

Mr. Orwig also will add Committee Meeting updates to the agenda.
