Regular Meeting  
September 27, 2021**

The regular meeting of the Princeton Elementary District #115 Board of Education was held Monday, September 27, 2021, at Logan Jr. High. The meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m. by President Steve Bouslog. The roll was called with the following members in attendance: Catherine Dye, Susan Garvin, Blake Jacobs, Judd Lusher, and Pete Reviglio, as well as President Bouslog. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Superintendent J.D. Orwig and Recording Secretary Lisa Bettner as well as several staff were also present.

**Superintendent's Report:**

The financial report was given in detail by Mr. Orwig. The revised Summary Sheet was explained as well as the updated budget figures. The deficit number is currently at \$19,812. However, later in the year there will be a working cash transfer of \$180,000. Mr. Orwig also explained how the students out of district expenditures will come during the next fiscal year. Questions addressed and answered by Mr. Orwig.

Mrs. Dye made a motion, second by Mr. Reviglio, to approve the hiring of Alanna Warren, as a paraprofessional at Jefferson. Roll call vote. All ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Mrs. Dye, second by Mr. Jacobs, to approve the maternity leave request of Jana Nordstrom, Lincoln Elementary teacher, from approximately Nov 8 for 10 weeks. Roll call vote. All ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. Jacobs, second by Mr. Lusher, to approve the recommended board policy updates. All ayes. Motion carried.

Mrs. Dye made a motion, second by Mr. Lusher, to adopt the FY 22 PES Budget, as presented. Roll call vote. All ayes. Motion carried.

Mr. Lusher made a motion, second by Mrs. Dye, to adopt the FY 22 BEST Budget, as presented at last month's meeting, with no changes. Roll call vote. All ayes. Motion carried.

Mr. Lusher made a motion, second by Mrs. Dye, to approve the ISBE Bullying Prevention Policy as presented by Mr. Orwig. All ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Mrs. Garvin, second by Mr. Reviglio, to approve the ARP Fund Allocation Plan. Roll call vote. All ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Mrs. Dye, second by Mr. Lusher, to approve the Substitute Paraprofessional raises for FY22, retroactive to the beginning of the school year, to \$12/ per hour. Roll call vote. All ayes. Motion carried.

**Future District / Board Considerations:** Mr. Bouslog asked that a portion of next months board meeting provide information regarding the Long-Term Planning process and placing the item on the agenda.
